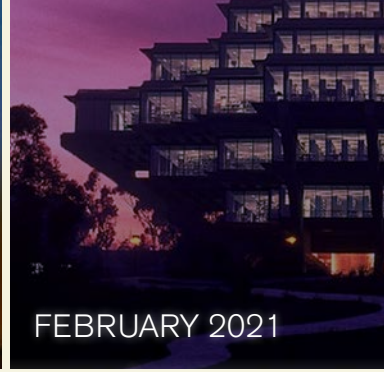

# MID-COAST TROLLEY CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

## SANTA FE STREET BIKEWAY PAVING

Beginning Tuesday, February 16 and continuing for approximately three weeks, crews will perform the final paving of the Rose Creek Bikeway on Santa Fe Street between Karl Strauss Brewing Company and Coventry Cars of San Diego. Traffic flow changes will be in effect on Santa Fe Street. One lane of travel will remain open at all times and flaggers will be present to direct traffic.

### What to Expect:

- Work hours will be Mondays through Fridays, from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. each day
- During the construction activities, through traffic access will remain open on Santa Fe Street and flaggers will be present; please expect traffic delays
- Driveway closures may be in effect and impacts are anticipated; however, access to properties will be maintained at all times
- Parking restrictions will continue to be in place on the west side of Santa Fe Street
- Please follow signage and use caution when traveling in the area
- Crews will minimize impacts as much as possible

## About the Project

The Rose Creek Bikeway is part of the Coastal Rail Trail and is a Class I bike path (completely separated from vehicle traffic). It connects existing sections of the Rose Canyon and Rose Creek bike paths in the City of San Diego.

The bikeway will begin at the north end of Santa Fe Street and connect to the existing Rose Creek Bike Path at the intersection of Damon Street and Mission Bay Drive.
