MID-COAST TROLLEY CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

W. MORENA BOULEVARD WIDENING AND LANE CLOSURES

Beginning Wednesday, January 13 and continuing for approximately three months, lane closures will be in place on W. Morena Boulevard for crews to widen the roadway and construct a pedestrian ramp. The ramp will provide a pedestrian walkway between Tecolote Road and W. Morena Boulevard, improving access to the future Tecolote Road Trolley Station.

What to Expect

- Work hours will be Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. each day
- Lane closures will be in place 24 hours a day on southbound and northbound W. Morena Boulevard; through traffic will be maintained and one lane will remain open in each direction
- This work may generate noise and back-up alarms may be heard; crews will minimize impacts as much as possible
- Access to local businesses will be maintained

Construction schedules may change with very little notice.

About the Project

The Mid-Coast Trolley project will extend UC San Diego Blue Line Trolley service from the Santa Fe Depot in Downtown San Diego to the University community, serving major activity centers such as Mission Bay, the VA Medical Center, UC San Diego, and University Towne Centre. Nine new stations will be constructed. Major construction work began in 2016, with service anticipated to begin in late 2021.
