



The list below shows planned closures and detours as part of highway, rail and lagoon improvement projects.

Week of July 31, 2017

HIGHWAY

- Motorists should expect intermittent lane and ramp closures, and reduced lane widths along Interstate 5 (I-5) Monday, July 31, through Friday, August 4, from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., between Lomas Santa Fe Drive and Birmingham Drive.
 - Nearby residents can expect intermittent noise and lights, and motorists can expect intermittent overnight lane closures on northbound and southbound I-5.
- Motorists should expect intermittent delays along Manchester Avenue as construction teams install trailers at their temporary construction yard in the northeast corner of the Manchester Avenue/I-5 interchange Monday, July 31, through Friday, August 4, from 6 a.m. to 5 p.m.

RAIL

- Residents near San Elijo Avenue, just north of the San Elijo Lagoon in Cardiff-by-the-Sea, can expect intermittent daytime construction noise and traffic delays from 7 a.m. – 7 p.m., Monday, July 31, through Friday, August 4, as crews construct the new rail bridge over the San Elijo Lagoon.
- Motorists should expect daytime closures along San Elijo Avenue from Dublin Drive to Norfolk Drive as crews work to construct a new retaining wall.
