



The list below shows planned closures and detours as part of highway, rail and lagoon improvement projects.

Week of September 4, 2017

HIGHWAY

- Motorists should expect intermittent lane and ramp closures, and reduced lane widths along Interstate 5 (I-5) Monday, September 4, 2017, through Friday, September 8, from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., between Lomas Santa Fe Drive and Birmingham Drive.
 - Nearby residents can expect intermittent noise and lights, and motorists can expect intermittent overnight lane closures on northbound and southbound I-5.
- Motorists should expect intermittent delays along Manchester Avenue beneath I-5 as construction teams install a temporary bridge support system along westbound Manchester Avenue Monday, September 4, 2017, through Friday, September 8, from 6 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- Motorists should expect the view point along southbound I-5, just north of Manchester Avenue, to close Monday, September 4, for approximately four years.

RAIL

- Residents near San Elijo Avenue, just north of the San Elijo Lagoon in Cardiff-by-the-Sea, can expect intermittent daytime construction noise and traffic delays from 7 a.m. – 7 p.m., Monday, September 4, 2017, through Friday, September 8, as crews construct the new rail bridge over the San Elijo Lagoon and retaining wall along San Elijo Avenue.
