










## Upcoming Construction: New HOV/Carpool Lanes - Stage 1

- Lanes shifted towards the outside of the highway














## Upcoming Construction: New HOV/Carpool Lanes - Stage 2

- Lanes shifted towards the inside of the highway









## Minimizing Construction Impacts





Construction crews will take all reasonable steps to minimize impacts to important coastal environmental resources, neighboring communities, and businesses. Mitigation measures include:

- No lane closures during the day
- Reducing truck movement through local streets
- Minimizing nighttime construction lighting and noise, when feasible
- Safeguarding construction materials near sensitive habitats
- Installing noise barriers around some construction equipment
- Providing 24 hour, 7 day a week Motorist Aid\* assistance to help get stranded motorists back on the highway
- Increasing litter collection and roadside maintenance through construction areas








Stage 2: 18 months





















### Carlsbad Sound Walls









## Chesterfield Drive Rail Crossing Improvements



### **Existing Conditions**



### Planned Improvements



- Will improve safety and access at Chesterfield Drive for people on bikes and walking
- Includes new sidewalk curb extensions with an ADA accessible sidewalk, new rail crossing warning lights and gates, wider street medians, and improved signage
- Planned construction timeline: Begins early 2017; complete early 2019


