

Construction Schedule – Night Work and Closures



The list below shows planned closures and detours as part of highway, rail, bike, pedestrian, and lagoon improvement projects. Detour signs will be placed, as needed, to assist motorists through closures. Please note, these closures are subject to change.


HIGHWAY

I-5 Traffic Shift – In early February, Build NCC highway construction crews will shift all Interstate 5 (I-5) travel lanes toward the center median – four lanes in both the northbound and southbound directions – between Manchester Avenue and Birmingham Drive in Encinitas. Preparatory overnight work for the traffic shifts will begin Monday, February 1, to relocate concrete barriers.

Crews anticipate striping the new travel lanes according to the schedule below*:

- Tuesday, February 2, (9 p.m. 5 a.m.) Northbound I-5
 - New northbound I-5 travel lanes opened to motorists on Wednesday, February 3, at 5 a.m.
- Thursday, February 4 (9 p.m. 5 a.m.) Southbound I-5
 - New southbound I-5 travel lanes opened to motorists on Friday, February 5, at 5 a.m.

*Please note, construction schedules are subject to change due to inclement weather conditions, including forecasted rain or fog.

Construction Schedule – Night Work and Closures



- Residents and motorists should expect intermittent nighttime construction noise, lane closures, and ramp closures along I-5 between Lomas Santa Fe Drive in Solana Beach and Palomar Airport Road in Carlsbad from Sunday, January 31, through Thursday, February 4, from 9 p.m. 5 a.m. for concrete barrier (k-rail) repositioning, vegetation removal, freeway lane striping, concrete paving, drainage installation, and maintenance.
- Residents and motorists should expect intermittent nighttime construction noise, lane closures, and ramp closures along Manchester Avenue at I-5 from Sunday, January 31, through Thursday, February 4, from 9 p.m. 5 a.m. for bridge foundation, bridge column, and falsework construction, and vegetation removal.
- Residents and motorists should expect intermittent daytime construction noise, flagging operations, and reduced lane widths along Manchester Avenue at I-5 from Monday, February 1, through Friday, February 5, from 7 a.m. 5 p.m. for bridge foundation, bridge column, and falsework construction.
- Residents and businesses should expect intermittent daytime construction noise along I-5 between Lomas Santa Fe Drive in Solana Beach and Palomar Airport Road in Carlsbad from Monday, February 1, through Friday, February 5, from 7 a.m. 5 p.m. for roadway excavation, earthwork hauling and placement, embankment construction, roadway demolition, roadway paving, barrier rail installation, median irrigation and planting installation, and drainage, electrical, and irrigation installation.

LAGOON/BIKE/PEDESTRIAN

- Residents and businesses along N. Rios Avenue in Solana Beach and Manchester Avenue in Encinitas
 can expect an increase in vehicle and equipment traffic as well as general vehicle noise and back-up
 alarms from Monday, February 1, through Friday, February 5, from 7 a.m. 5 p.m. for transport and hauling
 of dirt, equipment, plants, and other materials to and from the San Elijo Lagoon.
