

Construction Schedule – Night Work and Closures



The list below shows planned closures and detours as part of highway, rail, bike, pedestrian, and lagoon improvement projects. Detour signs will be placed, as needed, to assist motorists through closures. Please note, these closures are subject to change.

Week of July 12

HIGHWAY

• I-5 Weekend Ramp Closure – The northbound I-5 on-ramp from Encinitas Boulevard will be <u>CLOSED</u> to all motorists on Friday, July 10, at 9 p.m., and will reopen on Monday, July 13, at 5 a.m., for ramp realignment work. Motorists will be detoured around this closure with signage and traffic controls in place.

Construction Schedule – Night Work and Closures



- Residents and motorists should expect intermittent nighttime construction noise, lane closures, and ramp closures along I-5 between Lomas Santa Fe Drive and Palomar Airport Road from Sunday, July 12, through Thursday, July 16, from 7:30 p.m. 5 a.m. for concrete barrier (k-rail) repositioning and lane striping to shift I-5 Carpool/HOV Lane construction operations from the median to the outside shoulders, roadway excavation, earthwork hauling and placement, and maintenance.
- Residents and motorists should expect intermittent nighttime construction noise, lane closures, and ramp closures along **Manchester Avenue**, **Encinitas Boulevard**, and **Santa Fe Drive** at **I-5** from Sunday, July 12, through Thursday, July 16, from 7:30 p.m. 5 a.m. for bridge foundation, road, and bike/pedestrian work.
- Residents and motorists should expect intermittent daytime construction noise, flagging operations, and reduced lane widths along Manchester Avenue, Encinitas Boulevard, and Santa Fe Drive at I-5 from Monday, July 13, through Friday, July 17, from 7 a.m. 5 p.m. for bridge foundation, road, and bike/pedestrian work.
- Residents and businesses should expect intermittent daytime construction noise along I-5 between Lomas Santa Fe Drive in Solana Beach and Palomar Airport Road in Carlsbad from Monday, July 13, through Friday, July 17, from 7 a.m. 5 p.m. for earthwork hauling and placement, drainage installation, and vegetation clearing and removal in the outside freeway shoulders.

LAGOON/BIKE/PEDESTRIAN

- Residents and businesses along **N. Rios Avenue** in Solana Beach and **Manchester Avenue** in Encinitas can expect an increase in vehicle and equipment traffic as well as general vehicle noise and back-up alarms from Monday, July 13, through Friday, July 17, from 7 a.m. 5 p.m. for transport and hauling of dirt, equipment, plants, and other materials to and from the San Elijo Lagoon.
