HIGHWAY

I-5 Weekend Ramp Closure - Please see below for weekend ramp closure hours at the northbound I-5 offramp to Encinitas Boulevard for ramp realignment work. *Please note, construction schedules are subject to change.

CLOSED: Friday, June 12, at 9 p.m. - Sunday, June 14, at 6 a.m.

TEMPORARILY REOPENED TO ALL MOTORISTS: Sunday, June 14, from 6 a.m. - 4 p.m.

CLOSED: Sunday, June 14, at 4 p.m. - Monday, June 15, at 5 a.m.

Construction Schedule - Night Work and Closures



- Residents and motorists should expect intermittent nighttime construction noise, lane closures, and ramp closures along I-5 between Lomas Santa Fe Drive and Palomar Airport Road from Sunday, June 14, through Thursday, June 18, from 7:30 p.m. - 5 a.m. for concrete barrier (k-rail) repositioning and lane striping to shift I-5 Carpool/HOV Lane construction operations from the median to outside shoulders, concrete barrier formation and paving within the median, drainage installation, maintenance, and vegetation clearing and removal in the outside freeway shoulders.
- Residents and motorists should expect intermittent nighttime construction noise, lane closures, and ramp closures along Manchester Avenue, Encinitas Boulevard, and Santa Fe Drive at I-5 from Sunday, June 14, through Thursday, June 18, from 7:30 p.m. - 5 a.m. for bridge foundation, road, and bike/pedestrian work.
- Residents and motorists should expect intermittent daytime construction noise, flagging operations, and reduced lane widths along Manchester Avenue, Encinitas Boulevard, and Santa Fe Drive at I-5 from Monday, June 15, through Saturday, June 20, from 7 a.m. - 5 p.m. for bridge foundation, road, and bike/pedestrian work.
- Residents and businesses should expect intermittent daytime construction noise along I-5 between Lomas Santa Fe Drive in Solana Beach and Palomar Airport Road in Carlsbad from Monday, June 15, through Friday, June 19, from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m. for concrete barrier formation and paving within the median, planting in the median, soil excavation and vegetation clearing and removal in the outside freeway shoulders.

LAGOON/BIKE/PEDESTRIAN

- Residents and businesses along N. Rios Avenue in Solana Beach and Manchester Avenue in Encinitas can expect an increase in vehicle and equipment traffic as well as general vehicle noise and back-up alarms from Monday, June 15, through Saturday, June 20, from 7 a.m. - 5 p.m. for transport and hauling of dirt, equipment, plants, and other materials to and from the San Elijo Lagoon.
- Motorists may experience intermittent delays on eastbound Manchester Avenue, east of I-5 at the San Elijo Lagoon, from Monday, June 15, through Friday, June 19, from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m. for removal of a temporary soil work berm.
