

## Construction Schedule – Night Work and Closures



The list below shows planned closures and detours as part of highway, rail, bike, pedestrian, and lagoon improvement projects. Detour signs will be placed, as needed, to assist motorists through closures. Please note, these closures are subject to change.

## Week of May 17

## **HIGHWAY**

- Residents and motorists should expect intermittent nighttime construction noise, lane closures, and ramp closures along I-5 between Lomas Santa Fe Drive and Palomar Airport Road from Sunday, May 17, through Friday, May 22, from 7:30 p.m. 5 a.m. for concrete barrier (k-rail) repositioning and lane striping to shift I-5 Carpool/HOV Lane construction operations from the median to outside shoulders, concrete barrier formation and paving within the median, drainage installation, and vegetation clearing and removal in the outside freeway shoulders.
- Residents and motorists should expect intermittent nighttime construction noise, lane closures, and ramp closures along Encinitas Boulevard and Santa Fe Drive at I-5 from Monday, May 18, through Friday, May 22, from 7:30 p.m. 5 a.m. for road and bike/pedestrian work.
- Residents and motorists should expect intermittent daytime construction noise, flagging operations, and reduced lane widths along Manchester Avenue, Encinitas Boulevard, and Santa Fe Drive at I-5 from Monday, May 18, through Saturday, May 23, from 7 a.m. 5 p.m. for bridge column, road, and bike/pedestrian work.
- Motorists may experience delays due to intermittent daytime lane closures, ramp closures, and reduced lane widths along **Encinitas Boulevard** and **Santa Fe Drive** at **I-5** from Monday, May 18, through Sunday, May 24, from 5 a.m. 3 p.m. for road and bike/pedestrian work.
- Residents and businesses should expect intermittent daytime construction noise along I-5 between Lomas Santa Fe Drive in Solana Beach and Palomar Airport Road in Carlsbad from Monday, May 18, through Friday, May 22, from 7 a.m. 5 p.m. for concrete barrier formation and paving within the median, and vegetation clearing and removal in the outside freeway shoulders.

## LAGOON/BIKE/PEDESTRIAN

- Residents and businesses along **N. Rios Avenue** in Solana Beach and **Manchester Avenue** in Encinitas can expect an increase in vehicle and equipment traffic as well as general vehicle noise and back-up alarms from Monday, May 18, through Friday, May 22, from 7 a.m. 5 p.m. for transport and hauling of dirt, equipment, plants, and other materials to and from the San Elijo Lagoon.
