



Upcoming Solar Panel Installation

Starting Wednesday, February 16, SANDAG construction crews will install a temporary solar panel on the bluffs west of 4th Street. The work is necessary to power the irrigation system that will water the new vegetation being placed on the repaired bluff slope. This will begin the revegetation phase of the Del Mar Bluffs Emergency Repair.

What You Can Expect:

- **Solar panel installation on the bluffs west of 4th Street will begin on Wednesday, February 16, and continue intermittently for three weeks. Work hours will be 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday through Friday.**
- Crews will build a foundation, install a 10-foot pole, mount a solar panel on top, and connect the irrigation system.
- Residents may notice the presence of work crews, heavy construction equipment, noise, and Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) required vehicle back-up alarms.

This work is expected to create noise, however, crews are aware of residents in the area and will minimize impacts to the maximum extent possible. Please note, construction schedules are subject to change.



TRAIN HORN RULES

Federal regulations require the train engineer to sound the horn when approaching an active construction site, even in a quiet zone. Train horns serve as a warning system to ensure the safety of railroad workers.
