Closures

Beginning tonight, and throughout the week, the Interstate 5 (I-5)/ Genesee Avenue northbound off-ramp will be closed intermittently from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. for construction. During this same period, there will be lane closures on Genesee Avenue.

Construction schedules are subject to change.

Progress

Construction crews recently placed new bridge support columns in the median of I-5, just north of the existing Genesee Avenue overpass. These columns will support the new bridge. The public will soon see the erection of falsework, temporary support structures used to build the foundation of the new Genesee Avenue bridge.

Motorists should exercise caution and slow down during construction to help maintain safe travel conditions at the interchange. We appreciate your patience during construction.

About the Project

The \$105 million project will replace the existing six-lane Genesee Avenue overcrossing with a ten-lane structure that will include additional vehicle lanes, sidewalks, and bicycle lanes to better accommodate current and future traffic demands in the San Diego region.
