OLD TOWN TRANSIT CENTER PARKING LOT CLOSURES

Beginning Monday, July 26, and continuing through Monday, August 9, crews will make improvements to the Old Town Transit Center parking lots. These activities are part of ongoing improvements for the Old Town Transit Center. Improvements to the transit center and adjacent roadways are being made to prepare for the anticipated increase in Trolley crossings at Taylor Street upon completion of the Mid-Coast Trolley project.

What to Expect

- Work and closures will be in place beginning Monday, July 26, and will continue through Monday, August 9
- Closures will rotate throughout the different parking lots; two parking lots may be closed at a time, and access will be maintained for the remaining lot
- Each closure will be in place for 24 hours a day; please note that while regular work days will be Mondays through Fridays, some additional weekend work is required
- Crews will begin improvement activities in the north parking lot and will work their way south; a tentative schedule of parking lot closures is listed in the map provided on the following page
- Following the concrete repairs and improvements, crews will return to stripe the parking lots during non-revenue service hours

Construction schedules are subject to change.

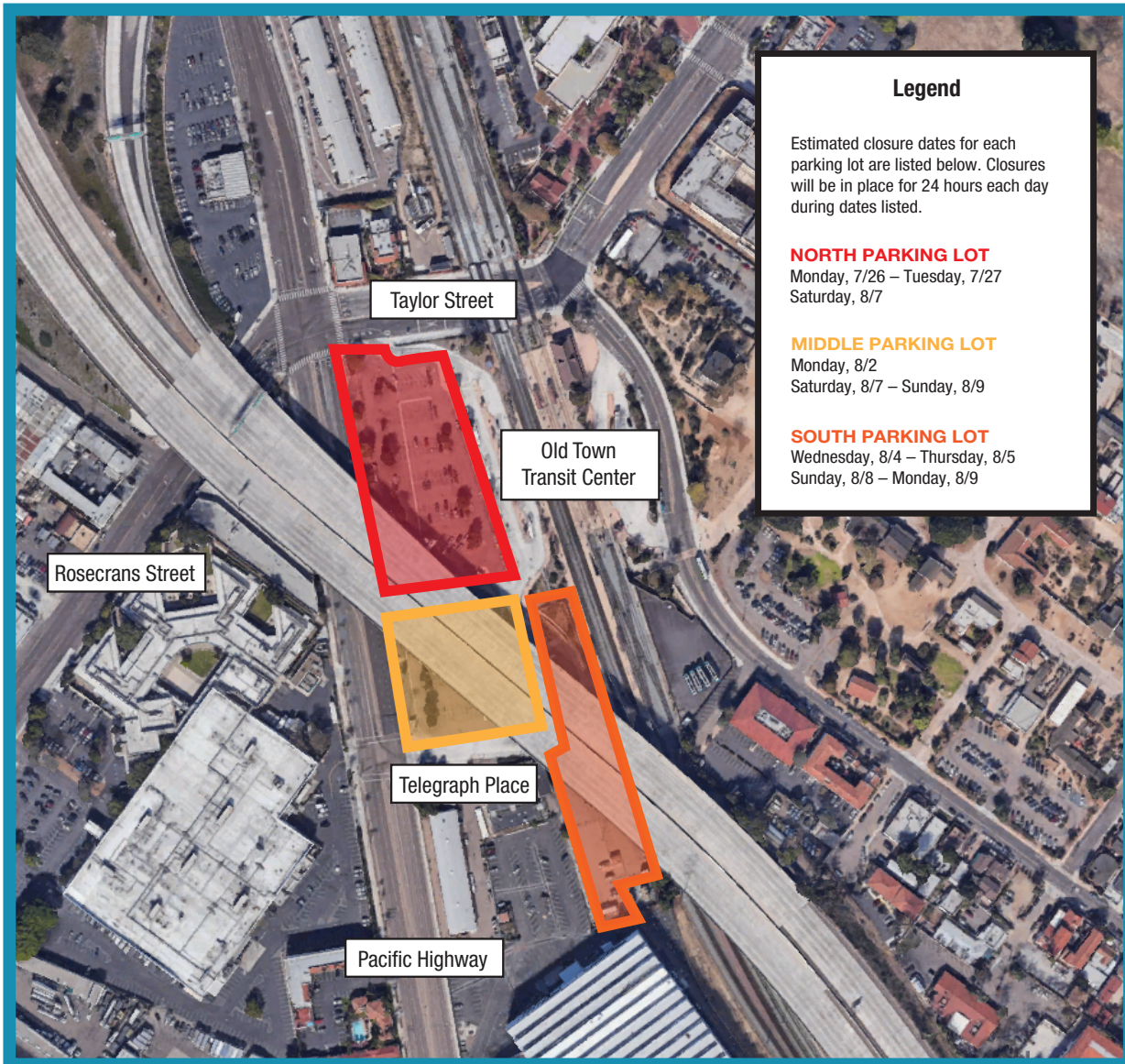

About the Project

The Mid-Coast Extension of the UC San Diego Blue Line will extend Trolley service from Downtown San Diego to the University Community, serving major activity centers such as Mission Bay, the VA Medical Center, UC San Diego, and University Towne Centre. Nine new stations will be constructed. Major construction work began in 2016, with service anticipated to begin in late 2021.
