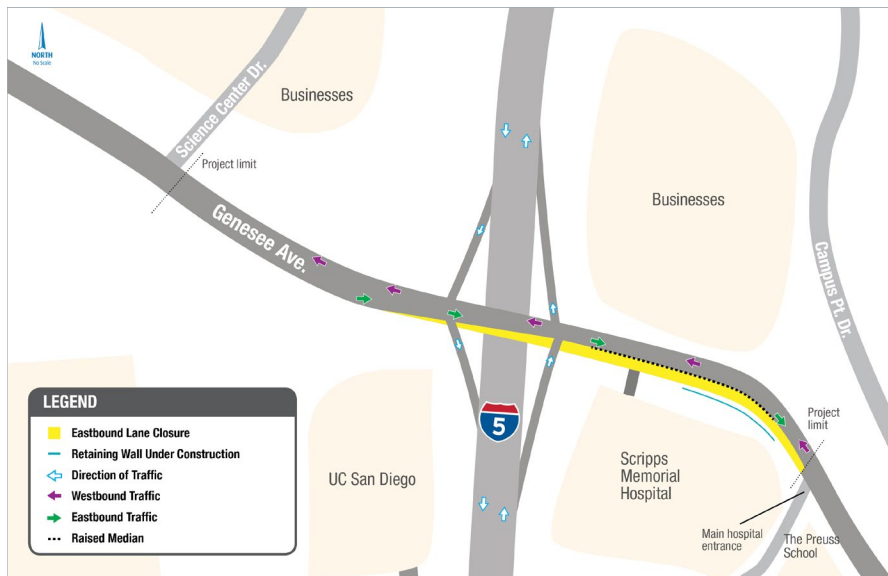
### Reduced Lanes Overnight on Genesee Avenue Through April 8

#### Closure

Over the next two weeks, motorists can expect reduced lanes overnight on Genesee Avenue between Interstate 5 (I-5) and the main entrance to Scripps Memorial Hospital. Crews will close lanes on eastbound Genesee Avenue to work on a retaining wall east of the freeway. During the closure, two-way traffic will shift to the westbound side of Genesee Avenue. See the map for details. Monday-Thursday night closures will occur between 7 p.m. and 5 a.m. On Fridays, closures will occur between 9 p.m. and 9 a.m. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained. We appreciate your patience as we work to improve the interchange.

#### Detour

Eastbound lanes will begin to narrow just west of the interchange. Two-way traffic will be maintained on the westbound side of Genesee Avenue during the closure. Flaggers will be on-site to assist motorists and bicyclists. Minimal delays are expected due to low nighttime traffic volumes.



#### Additional Closures

Throughout April, ongoing construction requires intermittent, overnight lane closures on I-5, Genesee Avenue, and the on- and off-ramps at the interchange. #### About the Project

The \$105 million project will replace the existing six-lane Genesee Avenue overcrossing with a ten-lane structure that will include additional vehicle lanes, new bicycle lanes and sidewalks, and better accommodate current and future traffic demands in the San Diego region.
