



Cardiff State Beach Nourishment

In December 2021, Caltrans and SANDAG Build NCC began beach nourishment efforts at Cardiff State Beach to help protect the area against coastal erosion, extreme storm waves, and projected sea level rise. The process includes relocating over 66,000 cubic yards of sand sourced from the San Elijo Lagoon Restoration project and transporting it to Cardiff State Beach. Additional beach nourishment efforts have been completed at Moonlight State Beach in Encinitas and Fletcher Cove in Solana Beach, for a total of over 506,000 cubic yards of sand added to the coastline since 2018.
