Interstate 5 and State Route 78 Interchange Project Public Workshop

On January 29th, Caltrans and SANDAG will hold a public workshop from 5-8 p.m. at the Carlsbad Senior Center (799 Pine Ave. Carlsbad, CA 92008) on proposed improvements to the Interstate 5 (I-5)/State Route 78 (SR-78) Interchange. The informational workshop will offer an opportunity for the public to learn about the proposed project and to provide feedback on future project scenarios.

Motorists traveling between SR-78 and I-5 experience significant delays due to the lack of direct freeway-to-freeway connections currently exist. These movements are currently

handled via a traffic signal at the I-5 southbound ramps/Vista Way intersection, which causes significant traffic delay impacts not only on the freeway, but within the adjacent community. Travel demand within the interchange is projected to increase, which will further exacerbate operations. The project team will be present to discuss and answer questions about the project's process and initial concepts for improving the interchange.

Caltrans will initiate the formal environmental review process for the project later this spring. Caltrans anticipates the Draft Environmental Impact Report/Environmental Impact Study (EIR/EIS) to be released in 2018. There will be additional opportunities for the public to comment on the project during the EIR/EIS review process.
