Motorists should be advised that there will be intermittent reduced lanes overnight on Interstate 5 (I-5) at Genesee Avenue Monday, January 16 from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. Additionally there will be reduced lanes on Genesee Avenue. These closures will allow construction crews to pour concrete to fill the beams inside and at the bottom of the second half of the new I-5/ Genesee Avenue Bridge.
