Overnight Closure of Genesee Avenue

Closure

From 9 p.m. on Thursday, October 6, to 5 a.m. on Friday, October 7, eastbound and westbound Genesee Avenue will be closed from just east of the Interstate 5 (I-5)/Genesee Avenue Bridge to approximately the Scripps Memorial Hospital main entrance. Additionally the northbound onramp from Genesee and northbound off-ramp to Genesee will be closed. These closures are required for crews to safely remove and replace a light pole in this section of Genesee Avenue. Hospital access for emergency vehicles will be maintained. Motorists will be detoured around the closure.

Additionally, during this timeframe there will be reduced lanes on northbound and southbound I-5 so crews can replace crash cushions in the median.

Please note construction schedules are subject to change. We appreciate your patience as we work to improve the interchange.
