

I-5 VEGETATION REMOVAL TO CONTINUE IN FALL 2020




1,500+ Trees to Be Replanted in Cleared Areas

This summer, Caltrans and SANDAG Build NCC crews transitioned Interstate 5 (I-5) Carpool/High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) Lane construction operations from the median to the outside shoulders.

Remaining trees and vegetation within State Right of Way will be removed along the east and west sides of the freeway, including along northbound I-5, between Poinsettia Lane and Palomar Airport Road in Carlsbad. This removal will provide crews space to continue construction on two new Carpool/HOV Lanes, one in each direction on I-5, between Lomas Santa Fe Drive in Solana Beach and Palomar Airport Road in Carlsbad.

Approximately 1,550 new Torrey Pines and Coast Live Oaks will be planted within the project limits, along with thousands of other native, drought-tolerant shrubs and hydroseeded groundcover in all cleared areas upon project completion in late 2021.
