Beach Nourishment Effort at Cardiff State Beach

Caltrans and SANDAG Build NCC crews began beach nourishment activity with dredging and pump equipment at Cardiff State Beach near tower 13 on Thursday, December 23, 2021. Beginning **March 7**, crews will also be **hauling sand to Cardiff State Beach** to ensure timely completion by April 2022. The \$870 million Build NCC project includes \$195 million in funding from Senate Bill 1 (SB 1) and \$322 million in TransNet funding.



Hauling will take place Monday – Friday from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. starting March 7. Residents and visitors can expect to see increased vehicle traffic, traffic control signage, and one-way flaggers. No major closures will occur. **Hauling to Cardiff State Beach will be complete mid-March.**

Sand for this nourishment is sourced from the San Elijo Lagoon. Sand is being dredged from the lagoon and piped out to Cardiff State Beach. Dredging activity will continue to take place **Monday – Saturday 24 hours a day** through March 2022. Crews will close off the area directly surrounding the equipment.

The beach will remain open throughout the replenishment period.

*Please note, construction schedules are subject to change due to inclement weather including forecasted rain, fog, or cold temperatures.

Nearby residents and businesses can expect construction noise and lights, including OSHA required vehicle back-up alarms. Crews will work to minimize noise and impacts to all nearby communities.

Senate Bill 1 (SB 1) provides \$5 billion in transportation funding annually split between the state and local agencies. Road projects progress through construction phases more quickly based on the availability of SB 1 funds, including projects that are partially funded by SB 1. A total of \$322 million in TransNet funding, the voter-approved half-cent sales tax administered by SANDAG, is allocated to the Build NCC package of highway, rail, environmental, and coastal access improvement projects.
