

Upcoming Roadway Work at Manchester Avenue in Cardiff-by-the-Sea

On **Monday, March 15**, Caltrans and SANDAG Build NCC construction crews will begin roadway demolition and excavation work along the north side of Manchester Avenue, between Ocean Cove Drive and MacKinnon Ranch Road, in Cardiff-by-the-Sea. These activities will facilitate the construction of a new pedestrian sidewalk that will fill an existing gap in the local network and further enhance east-west connectivity and coastal access.

This work is part of a series of new Build NCC bike and pedestrian improvements at the Interstate 5 (I-5)/Manchester Avenue, which includes construction of a new decomposed granite walking path on the south side of Manchester Avenue between the interchange and San Elijo Lagoon Nature Center, and new Class II bike lanes along Manchester Avenue.

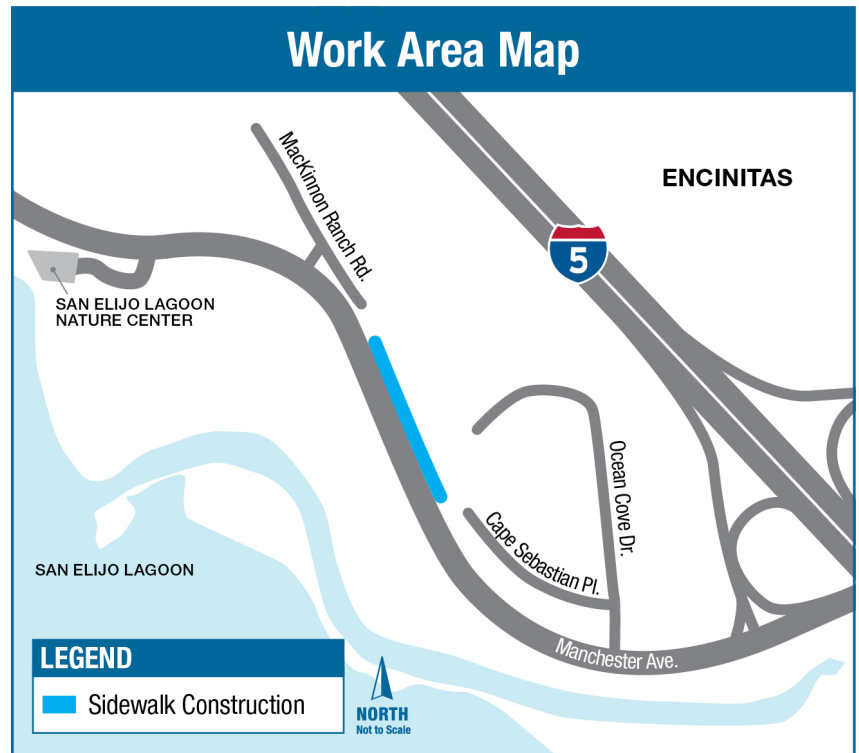
Construction Schedule*:

Roadway demolition and excavation will begin **Monday, March 15**, and will occur on weekdays during daytime shifts, between the hours of **7 a.m. – 5 p.m.** These activities are anticipated to be complete within approximately ***two weeks**. **Please note, construction schedules are subject to change due to inclement weather conditions, including rain or fog.*

What to Expect:

During construction, nearby residents can expect daytime construction noise and lights, including [OSHA required vehicle back-up alarms](#). Traffic controls and one-way directional flagging will be in place along eastbound and westbound Manchester Avenue between the hours of 7 a.m. – 5 p.m., to guide motorists around this work.
