

## Upcoming Roadway Work at Manchester Avenue in Cardiff-by-the-Sea



On Sunday, April 25, and Monday, April 26, Caltrans and SANDAG Build NCC construction crews will begin roadway restriping and place construction barriers along the south side of Manchester Avenue, between Ocean Cove Drive and the San Elijo Lagoon Nature Center, in Cardiff-by-the-Sea, to prepare for roadway improvements and trail construction.

This work is part of a series of new Build NCC bike and pedestrian improvements at the Interstate 5 (I-5)/Manchester Avenue, which includes the construction of a new decomposed granite walking path on the south side of Manchester Avenue between the interchange and San Elijo Lagoon Nature Center, and new Class II bike lanes along Manchester Avenue.

## **Construction Schedule\*:**

Roadway restriping and the placement of concrete barriers will begin on Sunday, April 25. This roadway work will occur during

nighttime hours (9 p.m. – 5 a.m.). Work is anticipated to be complete within approximately \*two days. \*Please note, construction schedules are subject to change due to inclement weather conditions, including forecasted rain or fog.

## What to Expect:

During construction, nearby residents can expect nighttime construction noise and lights, including OSHArequired vehicle back-up alarms. Traffic controls and one-way directional flagging will be in place along eastbound and westbound Manchester Avenue between the hours of 9 p.m. - 5 a.m., to guide motorists around this work.

In addition, "No Parking" signs will also be installed on the south side of Manchester Avenue near the Nature Center along the construction zone perimeter for the safety of crewmembers and the traveling public.
