# **Week of March 13**

# **HIGHWAY/BIKE/PEDESTRIAN**

- Residents and motorists should expect intermittent <u>nighttime</u> construction noise, lane closures, and ramp closures along I-5 between Lomas Santa Fe Drive in Solana Beach and Palomar Airport Road in Carlsbad from Sunday, March 13, through Wednesday, March 16, from 9 p.m. 5 a.m. for roadway striping, k-rail removal, utility installation, and maintenance.
- Residents and motorists should expect intermittent <u>nighttime</u> construction noise, lane closures, and ramp closures along **Manchester Avenue** at **I-5** from Sunday, March 13, through Wednesday, March 16, from 9 p.m. 5 a.m. for sewer line work and utility work.
- Residents and businesses should expect intermittent <u>daytime</u> construction noise along **I-5** between **Lomas Santa Fe Drive** in Solana Beach and **Palomar Airport Road** in Carlsbad from Monday, March 14, through Wednesday, March 16, from 7 a.m. 5 p.m. for roadway paving, sign placement, roadway striping, and k-rail removal.
- Residents and motorists should expect intermittent <u>daytime</u> construction noise, flagging operations, and reduced lane widths along **Manchester Avenue** at **I-5** from Monday, March 14, through Wednesday, March 16, and Friday, March 18, from 7 a.m. 5 p.m. for roadway work, pedestrian bridge work, manhole maintenance, and utility installation.
- Residents and motorists should expect intermittent <u>nighttime</u> construction noise, lane closures, and ramp closures along **I-5** between **Palomar Airport Road** in Carlsbad and **State Route 78 (SR 78)** in Oceanside from Monday, March 14, through Wednesday, March 16, and Friday, March 18, from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. for roadway excavation and drainage.
- Residents and motorists should expect intermittent <u>daytime</u> construction noise, lane closures, and ramp closures along I-5 between Palomar Airport Road in Carlsbad and State Route 78 (SR 78) in Oceanside from Monday, March 14, through Wednesday, March 16, and Friday, March 18, from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. for roadway excavation and drainage.

### **LAGOON**

• Residents and businesses along **N. Rios Avenue** in Solana Beach and **Manchester Avenue** in Encinitas can expect vehicle traffic as well as general noise and back-up alarms from Monday, March 14, through Wednesday, March 16, and Friday, March 18, from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m. for transport of equipment to and from the San Elijo Lagoon.












• Crews will temporarily close a portion of the Solana Hills Trail in the City of Encinitas from Monday, March 14, through Wednesday, March 16, and Friday, March 18, from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. for grading and placement of decomposed granite surfacing.
