CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

Upcoming Intermittent Nighttime WorkResidents can expect overnight construction noise and lighting

Crews will be conducting intermittent night work along Interstate 5 (I-5) between Lomas Santa Fe Drive and Birmingham Drive between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. beginning Tuesday, February 21, and continuing for approximately four weeks. This work is necessary to resurface and restripe I-5, as well as install concrete barriers to ensure the safety of construction crews and motorists during construction. Nearby residents can expect intermittent noise and lights, and motorists can expect intermittent overnight lane closures on I-5.

Restriping lanes and adding concrete barriers will result in reduced lane widths. Motorists can expect delays on I-5 and are encouraged to allow more time to reach their destination. Once the project is complete, lanes along I-5 will be restored to their normal configuration with the addition of one carpool lane in each direction.

Crews will work to keep noise and other impacts to nearby residents to a minimum during construction. Construction schedules are subject to change. Your patience during construction is appreciated.














About Build NCC

Build NCC is the first phase of construction of the North Coast Corridor (NCC) Program in the cities of Solana Beach, Encinitas, and Carlsbad. Build NCC includes extending the existing carpool lane on I-5 in each direction from Lomas Santa Fe Drive to State Route 78, double tracking the rail line at the San Elijo Lagoon, replacing the highway and rail bridges at the San Elijo and Batiquitos lagoons, restoring the San Elijo Lagoon, and constructing nearly 10 miles of new bike and pedestrian trails. Construction on Build NCC began in early 2017 and will be complete by 2021.
