

Nighttime Lane Closures on Northbound Interstate 5 from Lomas Santa Fe Dr. to Manchester Ave. January 25-26

Crews will remove trees and other vegetation along Interstate 5 (I-5) from Lomas Santa Fe Drive to Manchester Avenue overnight from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. on Wednesday, January 25, and Thursday, January 26. Nearby residents can expect intermittent noise and lights. During this time, motorists can expect intermittent lane closures northbound on I-5. Additionally, lane closures may continue during the week of January 29, as crews continue removing vegetation.

Construction crews are conducting preliminary work to replace the I-5 bridge over Manchester Avenue to extend the carpool lanes. Upon project completion in 2021, crews will replace removed vegetation and landscaping with drought-tolerant, native plants and trees.

Caltrans and SANDAG will work to minimize noise, lights, and other impacts to nearby residents during construction. Thank you for your patience as we work to improve the corridor.

About Build NCC

Build NCC is the first phase of construction of the North Coast Corridor (NCC) Program in the cities of Solana Beach, Encinitas, and Carlsbad. Build NCC includes extending the existing carpool lane on I-5 in each direction from Lomas Santa Fe Drive to State Route 78, double tracking the rail line at the San Elijo Lagoon, replacing the highway and rail bridges at the San Elijo and Batiquitos lagoons, restoring the San Elijo Lagoon, and construction nearly 10 miles of new bike and pedestrian trails. Construction on Build NCC began in early 2017 and will be complete by 2021.
