

Construction Schedule – Night Work and Closures



The list below shows planned closures and detours as part of highway, rail, bike, pedestrian, and lagoon improvement projects. Detour signs will be placed, as needed, to assist motorists through closures. Please note, these closures are subject to change.

Week of December 16

HIGHWAY

- Motorists should expect intermittent ramp closures, lane closures, flagging operations, and reduced lane widths along Interstate 5 (I-5), Manchester Avenue, Encinitas Boulevard, and Santa Fe Drive at I-5 from Sunday, December 16, through Thursday, December 20, from 9 p.m. 5 a.m. for carpool lane construction, bridge and road construction, and retaining wall work as part of the bike and pedestrian undercrossing improvements.
- Motorists should expect intermittent ramp closures, lane closures, flagging operations, and reduced lane widths along I-5, Manchester Avenue, Encinitas Boulevard, and Santa Fe Drive at I-5 from Monday, December 17, through Friday, December 21, from 7 a.m. 5 p.m. for carpool lane construction, road construction and retaining wall work as part of the bike and pedestrian undercrossing improvements.
- Sunday, December 16 Thursday, December 20: Residents and motorists may experience intermittent construction noise and lights from 9 p.m. 5 a.m. for sidewalk work as part of the bike and pedestrian undercrossing improvements on Santa Fe Drive and Encinitas Boulevard at I-5.

RAIL

- Residents and businesses near San Elijo Avenue, Coast Highway 101, and Chesterfield Drive, just north of the San Elijo Lagoon in Cardiff-by-the-Sea, can expect intermittent daytime construction noise and dust from Monday, December 17, through Friday, December 21, from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m. for continued work on the rail line and new rail bridge.
- Monday, December 10 Tuesday, January 1: Motorists may experience traffic delays at the Chesterfield
 Drive rail crossing intersection in Cardiff-by-the-Sea. Partial lane closures will be in place along the right
 southbound turn lane from San Elijo Avenue to Chesterfield Drive, the right westbound lane on Chesterfield
 Drive, and the right northbound turn lane from Chesterfield Drive to Coast Highway 101 as part of bike and
 pedestrian rail crossing improvements.

LAGOON/BIKE/PEDESTRIAN

- Residents and businesses near San Elijo Avenue, between Chesterfield Drive and Santa Fe Drive, in Cardiffby-the-Sea, can expect intermittent daytime construction noise, flagging, lane closures, and traffic delays from Monday, December 17, through Friday, December 21, from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m., for continued work on the Coastal Rail Trail bikeway.
