



The list below shows planned closures and detours as part of highway, rail and lagoon improvement projects.

Week of February 25

HIGHWAY

- Motorists should expect intermittent lane and ramp closures, and reduced lane widths along Interstate 5 (I-5) Monday, February 26, through Friday, March 2, from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., between Lomas Santa Fe Drive and Poinsettia Lane.
 - Nearby residents can expect intermittent noise and lights, and motorists can expect intermittent overnight lane closures on northbound and southbound I-5.
- Motorists should expect narrowed lanes along Devonshire Drive between Melba Road and Requeza Street Monday, February 26, through Friday, March 2, from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. as crews construct a privacy wall.
 - Nearby residents can expect intermittent noise and lights during construction hours.
- Businesses and residents near Manchester Avenue and I-5 can expect intermittent noise Monday, February 26, through Wednesday, February 28, from 7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. as crews install the highway bridge support columns.

RAIL

- Residents near San Elijo Avenue, just north of the San Elijo Lagoon in Cardiff-by-the-Sea, can expect intermittent daytime construction noise and traffic delays from 8 a.m. – 5 p.m., Monday, February 26, through Friday, March 2, as crews install new rail road ties south of Chesterfield Drive.
- Motorists should expect a road closure along San Elijo Avenue between Norfolk Avenue and Dublin Drive, from 8 a.m. – 5 p.m., Monday, February 26, through Friday, March 2, as crews deliver concrete structures for the new rail bridge over the San Elijo Lagoon.
