



The list below shows planned closures and detours as part of highway, rail, bike, pedestrian, and lagoon improvement projects. Detour signs will be placed, as needed, to assist motorists through closures. Please note, these closures are subject to change.

Saturday, June 30 and Week of July 1

Please note there will be no construction activity on Wednesday, July 4 due to the Independence Day holiday.

HIGHWAY

- Motorists should expect intermittent ramp closures, lane closures, flagging operations, and reduced lane widths along Encinitas Boulevard and Santa Fe Drive at Interstate 5 (I-5) from Sunday, June 24, through Thursday, July 5, from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. for crews to work on retaining wall construction.
- Motorists should expect intermittent ramp closures, lane closures, flagging operations, and reduced lane widths along Manchester Avenue at Interstate 5 (I-5) from Sunday, July 1, through Thursday, July 5 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. for crews to work on road paving, ramp paving, and bridge work.
- **Saturday, June 30:** Work on the highway bridge is expected to take place just south of Manchester Avenue under the I-5 highway bridge beginning at 2 a.m. and continuing through 5 p.m. Nearby residents and businesses can expect intermittent noise and lights during early morning hours while construction activities are taking place. All reasonable steps will be taken to minimize impacts to residents.

RAIL

- Residents near San Elijo Avenue, just north of the San Elijo Lagoon in Cardiff-by-the-Sea, can expect intermittent daytime construction noise, flagging, and traffic delays from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m., Monday, July 2, through Friday, July 6, as crews construct a new curb and cutter, and install new railroad track.
- **Saturday, June 30:** Early morning maintenance work is schedule to take place in Cardiff-by-the-Sea from 12:01 – 7 a.m., between approximately Montgomery Avenue and Chesterfield Drive. Nearby residents and businesses can expect intermittent noise and lights during early morning hours while construction activities are taking place. All reasonable steps will be taken to minimize impacts to residents.

LAGOON/BIKE/PEDESTRIAN

- Residents and businesses near San Elijo Avenue, between Chesterfield Drive and Santa Fe Drive in Cardiff-by-the-Sea, can expect intermittent daytime construction noise from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m., Monday, July 2 through Friday, July 6, as crews continue work on the Coastal Rail Trail bike path.
- Residents, businesses, and visitors may experience increased activity and noise along Cardiff State Beach in the City of Encinitas due to work to demobilize beach sand replenishment equipment from the beach.
