



The list below shows planned closures and detours as part of highway, rail, bike, pedestrian, and lagoon improvement projects. Detour signs will be placed, as needed, to assist motorists through closures. Please note, these closures are subject to change.

Week of July 8

HIGHWAY

- Motorists should expect intermittent ramp closures, lane closures, flagging operations, and reduced lane widths along Encinitas Boulevard and Santa Fe Drive at Interstate 5 (I-5) from Sunday, July 8, through Thursday, July 12, from 9 p.m. – 5 a.m. for crews to work on retaining wall construction.
- **Monday, July 9, to Thursday, July 12:** Motorists should expect overnight closures of Manchester Avenue in both directions at I-5 from 9 p.m. – 5 a.m. to allow crews to install falsework – temporary wooden support structures used to aid in the construction of bridges. Motorists will be detoured around the closure using the freeway. Detours signs will be placed on Manchester Avenue and I-5 to advise motorists of the closure.

RAIL

- Residents near San Elijo Avenue, just north of the San Elijo Lagoon in Cardiff-by-the-Sea, can expect intermittent daytime construction noise, flagging, and traffic delays from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m., Monday, July 9, through Friday, July 13, as crews construct a new curb and cutter, and install new railroad track.

LAGOON/BIKE/PEDESTRIAN

- Residents and businesses near San Elijo Avenue, between Chesterfield Drive and Santa Fe Drive in Cardiff-by-the-Sea, can expect intermittent daytime construction noise from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m., Monday, July 9 through Friday, July 13, as crews continue work on the Coastal Rail Trail bike path.
