



The list below shows planned closures and detours as part of highway, rail, bike, pedestrian, and lagoon improvement projects. Detour signs will be placed, as needed, to assist motorists through closures. Please note, these closures are subject to change.

### Week of June 17

#### HIGHWAY

- Motorists should expect intermittent ramp closures, lane closures, flagging operations, and reduced lane widths along Encinitas Boulevard and Santa Fe Drive at Interstate 5 (I-5) from Sunday, June 17, through Thursday, June 21, from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. for crews to work on retaining wall construction.
- Motorists should expect intermittent ramp closures, lane closures, flagging operations, and reduced lane widths along Manchester Avenue at Interstate 5 (I-5) from Sunday, June 17, through Thursday, June 21 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. for crews to work on road paving, ramp paving, and retaining wall work.

#### RAIL

- Residents near San Elijo Avenue, just north of the San Elijo Lagoon in Cardiff-by-the-Sea, can expect intermittent daytime construction noise, flagging, and traffic delays from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m., Monday, June 18, through Friday, June 22, as crews construct a new curb and cutter, and install new railroad track.

#### LAGOON/BIKE/PEDESTRIAN

- Residents and businesses near San Elijo Avenue, between Chesterfield Drive and Santa Fe Drive in Cardiff-by-the-Sea, can expect intermittent daytime construction noise from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m., Monday, June 18 through Friday, June 22, as crews continue work on the Coastal Rail Trail bike path.
- Residents, businesses, and visitors may experience increased activity and noise along Cardiff State Beach in the City of Encinitas due to work to demobilize beach sand replenishment equipment from the beach.
