



The list below shows planned closures and detours as part of highway, rail and lagoon improvement projects. Detour signs will be placed, as needed, to assist motorists through closures. Please note, these closures are subject to change.

Week of May 6

HIGHWAY

- Motorists should expect narrowed lanes along Devonshire Drive between Melba Road and Requeza Street from Monday, May 7, through Friday, May 11, from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. as crews construct a privacy wall.
 - Nearby residents can expect intermittent noise and lights, and flagging operations during construction hours.
- Motorists should expect intermittent ramp closures, lane closures, and reduced lane widths along Encinitas Boulevard and Santa Fe Drive at Interstate 5 (I-5) from Sunday, May 6, through Thursday, May 10, from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. for crews to work on retaining walls under the freeway.
- Motorists should expect intermittent ramp closures, lane closures, and reduced lane widths along Manchester Avenue at I-5 from Sunday, May 6, through Thursday, May 10 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. for crews to work on the relocation of utilities.
 - **Tuesday and Wednesday, May 8-9:** Construction crews will close westbound Manchester Avenue at I-5 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. to allow crews to conduct paving operations. Two-way traffic will be maintained on the eastbound side.
 - **Thursday, May 10:** Construction crews will close eastbound and westbound Manchester Avenue at I-5 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. to allow crews to restripe Manchester Avenue in preparation to shift all traffic onto new paving. Detour signs will be placed to detour motorists around the closure.

RAIL

- Residents near San Elijo Avenue, just north of the San Elijo Lagoon in Cardiff-by-the-Sea, can expect intermittent daytime construction noise and traffic delays from 8 a.m. – 5 p.m., Monday, May 6, through Friday, May 11, as crews install new rail road track.

LAGOON/BIKE/PEDESTRIAN

- Residents and businesses may experience intermittent no-parking restrictions along San Elijo Avenue between Chesterfield Avenue and Santa Fe Drive from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m, to allow for Coastal Rail Trail crews to verify underground utilities.
- Residents, businesses, and visitors may experienced increased activity and noise along Cardiff State Beach in the City of Encinitas and Fletcher Cove beach in the City of Solana Beach due to on-going beach sand replenishment activities.
