

# Construction Schedule – Night Work and Closures



The list below shows planned closures and detours as part of highway, rail, bike, pedestrian, and lagoon improvement projects. Detour signs will be placed, as needed, to assist motorists through closures. Please note, these closures are subject to change.

# Week of April 26

# **HIGHWAY**

- Residents and motorists should expect intermittent nighttime construction noise, lane closures, and ramp closures along **I-5** between **Lomas Santa Fe Drive** and **Palomar Airport Road** from Monday, April 27, through Friday, May 1, from 7:30 p.m. 5 a.m. for concrete barrier formation and paving within the median, material hauling, and vegetation clearing and removal in the outside freeway shoulders.
- Residents and motorists should expect intermittent daytime construction noise, flagging operations, and reduced lane widths along Manchester Avenue, Encinitas Boulevard, and Santa Fe Drive at I-5 from Monday, April 27, through Saturday, May 2, from 7 a.m. 5 p.m. for bridge column, road, and bike/pedestrian work.
- Motorists may experience delays due to intermittent daytime lane closures and reduced lane widths along
   Encinitas Boulevard and Santa Fe Drive at I-5 from Monday, April 27, through Sunday, May 3, from 5 a.m.
   3 p.m. for road and bike/pedestrian work.
- Residents and businesses should expect intermittent daytime construction noise along I-5 between Lomas Santa Fe Drive in Solana Beach and Palomar Airport Road in Carlsbad from Monday, April 27, through Friday, May 1, from 7 a.m. 5 p.m. for concrete barrier formation and paving within the median, and vegetation clearing and removal in the outside freeway shoulders.

### **RAIL**

• Residents and businesses along **Seabright Lane** and **Coast Highway 101** in Solana Beach should expect intermittent daytime construction noise as well as general vehicle noise and back-up alarms from Monday, April 27, through Friday, May 1, from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m. for chain-link and lodge pole fencing installation along the east and west sides of the LOSSAN rail line.

## LAGOON/BIKE/PEDESTRIAN

- Residents and businesses along N. Rios Avenue in Solana Beach and Manchester Avenue in Encinitas
  can expect an increase in vehicle and equipment traffic as well as general vehicle noise and back-up
  alarms from Monday, April 27, through Friday, May 1, from 7 a.m. 5 p.m. for transport and hauling of dirt,
  equipment, plants, and other materials to and from the San Elijo Lagoon.
