



The list below shows planned closures and detours as part of highway, rail, bike, pedestrian, and lagoon improvement projects. Detour signs will be placed, as needed, to assist motorists through closures. Please note, these closures are subject to change.

Week of February 3

HIGHWAY

- Motorists should expect intermittent lane and ramp closures along northbound Interstate 5 (I-5) between Manchester Avenue and Palomar Airport Road from Sunday, February 3, through Thursday, February 7, from 9 p.m. – 5 a.m. for crews to place concrete barriers (k-rail) along the inside shoulder of I-5.
- Motorists should expect intermittent ramp closures, lane closures, flagging operations, and reduced lane widths along Manchester Avenue, Birmingham Drive, La Costa Avenue, Encinitas Boulevard, and Santa Fe Drive at I-5 from Sunday, February 3, through Thursday, February 7, from 9 p.m. – 5 a.m. for bridge, road, bike/pedestrian, and retaining wall work.
- Motorists should expect intermittent flagging operations and reduced lane widths along Manchester Avenue, Encinitas Boulevard, and Santa Fe Drive at I-5 from Monday, February 4, through Friday, February 8, from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m. for bridge, road, bike/pedestrian, and retaining wall work.

RAIL

- Residents and businesses near San Elijo Avenue, Coast Highway 101, and Chesterfield Drive, just north of the San Elijo Lagoon in Cardiff-by-the-Sea, can expect intermittent daytime construction noise and dust from Monday, February 4, through Friday, February 8, from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m. for continued work on the rail line and new rail bridge.
- **Saturday, February 9 – Sunday, February 10 (ABSOLUTE WORK WINDOW), 24/7:** Weekend construction work is scheduled along the rail line during a planned Absolute Work Window (AWW). Residents and travelers can expect a complete closure of rail services and intermittent construction noise, flagging, and traffic delays.

LAGOON/BIKE/PEDESTRIAN

- Residents and businesses near San Elijo Avenue, between Chesterfield Drive and Santa Fe Drive, in Cardiff-by-the-Sea, can expect intermittent daytime construction noise, flagging, lane closures, and traffic delays from Monday, February 4, through Friday, February 8, from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m., for continued work on the Coastal Rail Trail bikeway.
- Motorists and businesses near Coast Highway 101 near the San Elijo Lagoon inlet in Cardiff-by-the-Sea can expect intermittent daytime construction noise, narrowed lanes, and/or controlled traffic flagging operations from Monday, February 4, through Friday, February 8, from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m. as crews construct rock slope protection along the west basin of the San Elijo Lagoon as part of the San Elijo Lagoon Restoration Project.
