



The list below shows planned closures and detours as part of highway, rail, bike, pedestrian, and lagoon improvement projects. Detour signs will be placed, as needed, to assist motorists through closures. Please note, these closures are subject to change.

## Week of January 20

### HIGHWAY

- Motorists should expect intermittent lane and ramp closures along northbound Interstate 5 (I-5) between Manchester Avenue and Palomar Airport Road from Sunday, January 20, through Thursday, January 24, from 9 p.m. – 5 a.m. for crews to place concrete barriers (k-rail) along the inside shoulder of I-5.
- Motorists should expect intermittent ramp closures, lane closures, flagging operations, and reduced lane widths along Manchester Avenue, Encinitas Boulevard, and Santa Fe Drive at I-5 from Sunday, January 20, through Thursday, January 24, from 9 p.m. – 5 a.m. for bridge, road, bike/pedestrian, and retaining wall work.
- Motorists should expect intermittent flagging operations and reduced lane widths along Manchester Avenue, Encinitas Boulevard, and Santa Fe Drive at I-5 from Monday, January 21, through Friday, January 25, from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m. for bridge, road, bike/pedestrian, and retaining wall work.

### RAIL

- **January 1 – 23, 24/7 (Chesterfield Drive Rail Crossing Improvements Project):** A full intersection closure restricting eastbound and westbound motor vehicle access is in place at the Chesterfield Drive rail crossing intersection in Cardiff-by-the-Sea. Motorists may experience traffic delays near the Chesterfield Drive rail crossing intersection as crews construct rail crossing improvements and pedestrian/bike accessibility and safety improvements. Access for bikes and pedestrians will be maintained.
- Residents and businesses near San Elijo Avenue, Coast Highway 101, and Chesterfield Drive, just north of the San Elijo Lagoon in Cardiff-by-the-Sea, can expect intermittent daytime construction noise and dust from Monday, January 21, through Friday, January 25, from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m. for continued work on the rail line and new rail bridge.

### LAGOON/BIKE/PEDESTRIAN

- Residents and businesses near San Elijo Avenue, between Chesterfield Drive and Santa Fe Drive, in Cardiff-by-the-Sea, can expect intermittent daytime construction noise, flagging, lane closures, and traffic delays from Monday, January 21, through Friday, January 25, from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m., for continued work on the Coastal Rail Trail bikeway.
