

Construction Schedule – Night Work and Closures



The list below shows planned closures and detours as part of highway, rail, bike, pedestrian, and lagoon improvement projects. Detour signs will be placed, as needed, to assist motorists through closures. Please note, these closures are subject to change.

Week of July 14

HIGHWAY

- Residents and motorists should expect intermittent nighttime construction noise, lane closures, and ramp closures along **Interstate 5 (I-5)** between **Lomas Santa Fe Drive** and **Palomar Airport Road** from Sunday, July 14, through Thursday, July 18, from 9 p.m. 5 a.m. for material hauling from the highway median.
- Residents and motorists should expect intermittent nighttime construction noise and lights, lane closures, flagging operations, and reduced lane widths on **Manchester Avenue**, **Santa Fe Drive**, **and Encinitas Boulevard** at I-5 from Sunday, July 14, through Thursday, July 18, from 9 p.m. 5 a.m. for bridge, road, and bike/pedestrian work.
- Motorists should expect intermittent daytime construction noise, flagging operations, and reduced lane widths along Manchester Avenue, Encinitas Boulevard, and Santa Fe Drive at I-5 from Monday, July 15, through Friday, July 19, from 7 a.m. 5 p.m. for bridge, road, and bike/pedestrian work.

RAIL

- Residents and businesses near San Elijo Avenue, Coast Highway 101, and Chesterfield Drive, just north of the San Elijo Lagoon in Cardiff-by-the-Sea, can expect intermittent daytime construction noise from Monday, July 15, through Friday, July 19, from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m. for ballast retaining wall construction, revegetation and site clean-up.
- Motorists on **San Elijo Avenue** and **Coast Highway 101** at **Chesterfield Drive** can expect intermittent delays from Monday, July 15, through Thursday, July 18, during daytime and overnight construction for electrical work and traffic signal installation.

LAGOON/BIKE/PEDESTRIAN

- Residents and businesses near **San Elijo Avenue**, between **Chesterfield Drive** and **Santa Fe Drive** in Cardiff-by-the-Sea, can expect intermittent daytime construction from Monday, July 15, through Friday, July 19, from 7 a.m. 5 p.m., for revegetation and site clean-up on the Coastal Rail Trail bikeway.
- Motorists and businesses along Coast Highway 101, between the San Elijo Lagoon inlet and southern end of the San Elijo Lagoon west basin in Cardiff-by-the-Sea can expect intermittent daytime construction noise, narrowed lanes, and/or controlled traffic flagging operations from Monday, July 15, through Friday, July 19, from 7 a.m. 5 p.m. for rock slope protection work along the west basin as part of the San Elijo Lagoon Restoration Project.
