

Construction Schedule – Night Work and Closures



The list below shows planned closures and detours as part of highway, rail, bike, pedestrian, and lagoon improvement projects. Detour signs will be placed, as needed, to assist motorists through closures. Please note, these closures are subject to change.

Week of May 5

HIGHWAY

- Residents & motorists should expect intermittent nighttime construction noise, lane closures, and ramp closures along Interstate 5 (I-5) between **Lomas Santa Fe Drive** and **Palomar Airport Road** from Sunday, May 5, through Thursday, May 9, from 9 p.m. 5 a.m. for material hauling from the highway median.
- Residents & motorists should expect intermittent nighttime construction noise, ramp closures, lane closures, flagging operations, and reduced lane widths along Interstate 5, Manchester Avenue, Birmingham Drive, La Costa Avenue, and Santa Fe Drive at I-5 from Sunday, May 5, through Thursday, May 9, from 9 p.m. 5 a.m. for highway median, bridge, road, bike/pedestrian, and retaining wall work.
- Monday, May 6 Tuesday, May 7, 9 p.m. through 5 a.m. (NIGHTWORK): Residents & motorists can expect a full overnight eastbound closure on Encinitas Boulevard at the I-5 undercrossing for street paving construction. A motor vehicle detour route and signage will be in place to direct motorists around this nighttime closure. Please note, westbound access on Encinitas Boulevard will be maintained.
- Motorists should expect intermittent daytime construction noise, flagging operations, and reduced lane widths along Manchester Avenue, Encinitas Boulevard, and Santa Fe Drive at I-5 from Monday, May 6, through Friday, May 10, from 7 a.m. 5 p.m. for bridge, road, bike/pedestrian, and retaining wall work.

 Residents and businesses near San Elijo Avenue, Coast Highway 101, and Chesterfield Drive, just north of the San Elijo Lagoon in Cardiff-by-the-Sea, can expect intermittent daytime construction noise from Monday, May 6, through Friday, May 10, from 7 a.m. – 5 p.m. for irrigation and revegetation work.

LAGOON/BIKE/PEDESTRIAN

- Residents and businesses near San Elijo Avenue, between Chesterfield Drive and Santa Fe Drive in Cardiff-by-the-Sea, can expect intermittent daytime construction noise, flagging, one-way lane closures, and traffic delays from Monday, May 6, through Friday, May 10, from 7 a.m. 5 p.m., for continued work on the Coastal Rail Trail bikeway.
- Motorists and businesses along Coast Highway 101 between the San Elijo Lagoon inlet and southern end of the San Elijo Lagoon west basin in Cardiff-by-the-Sea can expect intermittent daytime construction noise, narrowed lanes, and/or controlled traffic flagging operations from Monday, May 6, through Friday, May 10, from 7 a.m. 5 p.m. for rock slope protection work along the west basin of the San Elijo Lagoon as part of the San Elijo Lagoon Restoration Project.
- Businesses on Coast Highway 101 between the San Elijo Lagoon inlet and southern end of the San Elijo Lagoon
 west basin in Cardiff-by-the-Sea can expect equipment noise from ongoing dredging operations from Monday, May
 6, through Saturday, May 11, as part of the San Elijo Lagoon Restoration Project.
