



The list below shows planned construction activities for the South Bay *Rapid* project. Travelers are encouraged to allow extra time to reach their destination or consider using alternate routes. Please note, construction schedules are subject to change.

Construction activities for the week of November 6

Heritage Road to Olympic Parkway – City of Chula Vista

- Periodic noise, dust, lane closures, and reduced on-street parking in both directions along East Palomar Street between Santa Andrea Avenue and Heritage Road for landscaping improvements
- **POSTPONED-** Overnight work along East Palomar Street between Santa Andrea Avenue and Heritage Road from 7 p.m. Tuesday, November 7 to 5 a.m. Wednesday, November 8, for final road striping activities
- **POSTPONED-** Possible overnight work along East Palomar Street between Olympic Parkway and Heritage Road from 7 p.m. Tuesday, November 7 to 5 a.m. Wednesday, November 8, for final road striping activities

Olympic Parkway to State Route 125 (SR 125) – City of Chula Vista

- Periodic noise and dust along Impressionist Drive for construction of the guideway bridge
- Lane closures along northbound and southbound SR 125 between Olympic Parkway and Birch Road for construction of the guideway bridge

Town Center Drive to Birch Road – City of Chula Vista

- Work near the Otay Ranch Town Center has been put on hold during the busy shopping season for public safety and convenience

Millenia – City of Chula Vista

- Periodic noise and dust near the Millenia development for construction of the dedicated transit guideway and Millenia *Rapid* Station

Nicola Tesla Court – City of San Diego

- Periodic lane closures on the eastbound State Route 905 (SR 905) on- and off-ramps at Siempre Viva Road from Monday, November 6 – Thursday, November 9, between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m., to accommodate construction of a retaining wall
 - November 6: lane closure on eastbound SR 905 on-ramp

Planned Construction Activities

- November 7: full closure of eastbound SR 905 on-ramp and off-ramp toward westbound Siempre Viva Rd. Motorists wishing to travel eastbound on SR 905 or exit SR 905 via westbound Siempre Viva Road will be detoured to the La Media Road on- and off-ramps.
- November 8: lane closure on eastbound SR 905 on-ramp
- November 9: lane closure on eastbound SR 905 on-ramp
- Periodic noise, dust, and reduced on-street parking at Nicola Tesla Court near the Otay Mesa Port of Entry to accommodate grading and construction of storm drain facilities and a retaining wall
 - No on-street parking on south side of Nicola Tesla Court
