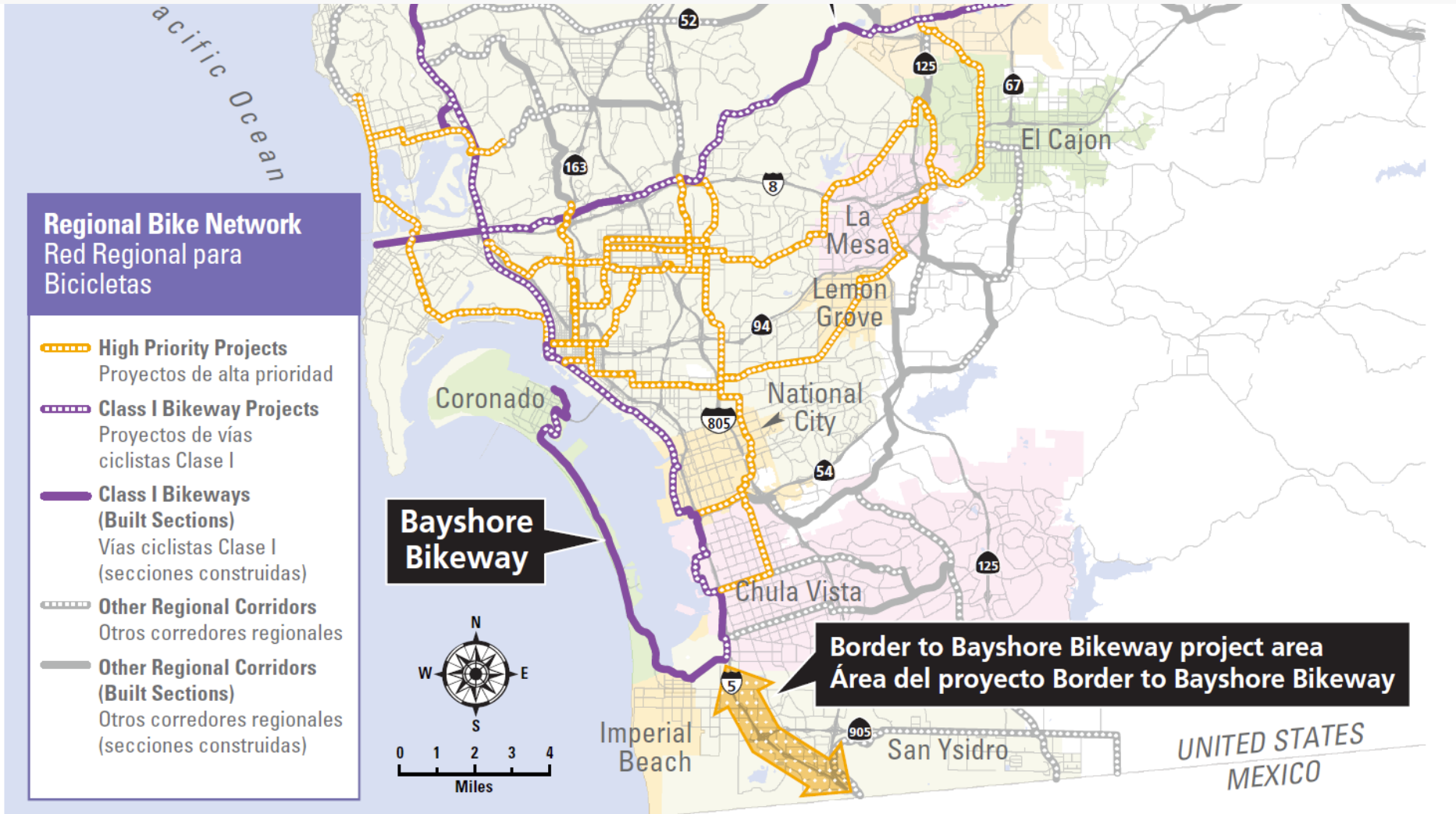

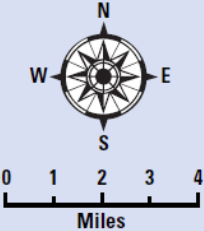

BIKE EAP DESIGN PRICIPLES

SAFE “LOW STRESS” STREETS

- Safe movement of people
- Protected bikeways provide separation
- Traffic calming to reduce speeds
- Challenges in urban areas due to limited space and competing uses

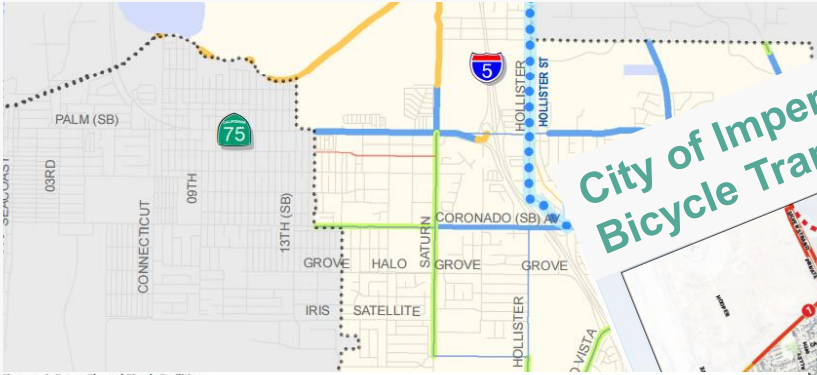


Figure 3-6: Future Planned Bicycle Facilities

Otay Mesa-Nestor Community Plan / Plan Comunitario de Otay Mesa-Nestor

Bike Path - a Class I Bikeway with a physically separate right-of-way for the exclusive use of bicycles.
Bike Lane - a Class II bikeway with a restricted right-of-way identified by lane striping in a roadway.
Bike Route - a Class III bikeway that shares the roadway with other vehicles and identified by signage only.

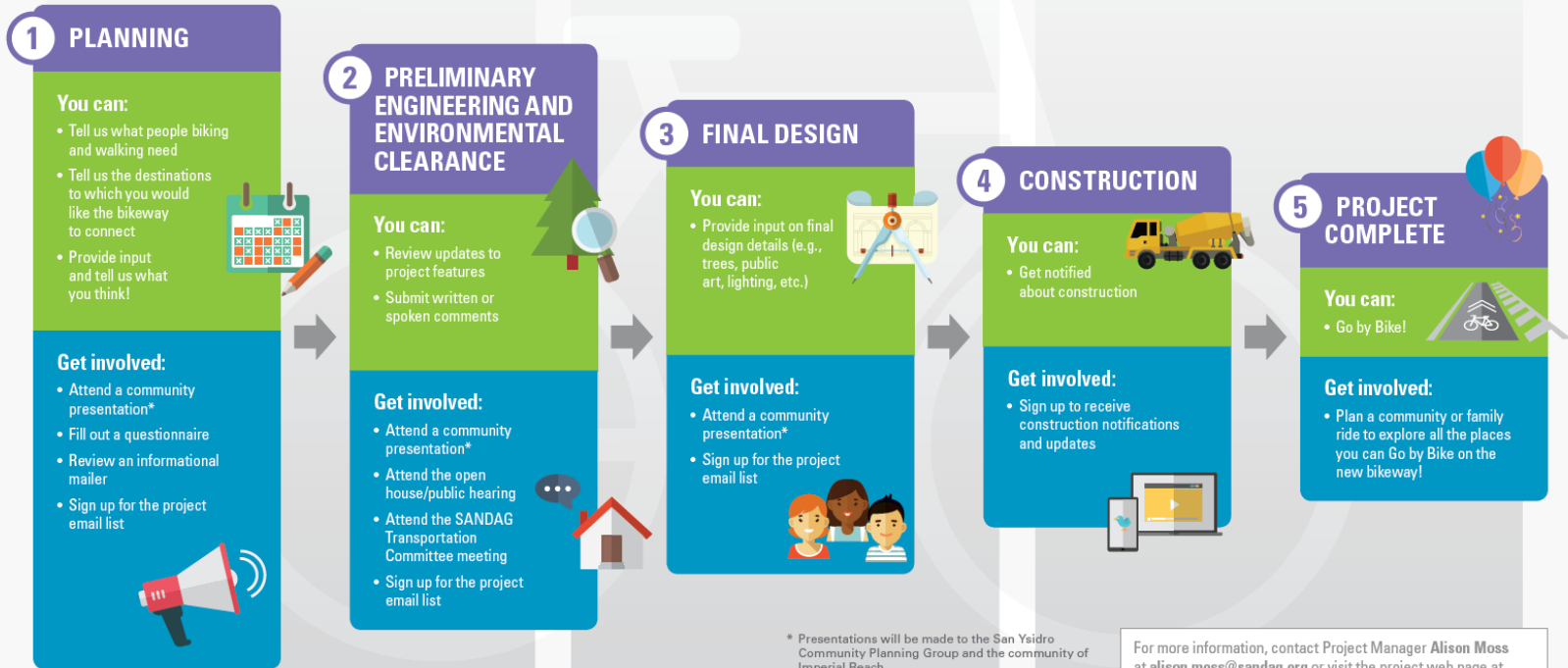
