The San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG), in partnership with the City of Encinitas and North County Transit District, will host an open house to introduce the Chesterfield Drive to E Street segment of the Coastal Rail Trail on Thursday, November 14, 6-8 PM, in the Poinsettia Room at Encinitas City Hall. Please come to the open house-style meeting to discuss the project and share ideas for this important regional bikeway segment.

The Coastal Rail Trail in Encinitas is planned as a multi-use path, separated from motor vehicle traffic. The initial two-mile segment from Chesterfield Drive to E Street would be the first reach of the Coastal Rail Trail in Encinitas, and would add a significant piece to the regional bicycle network. The overall project goal is to provide a comfortable bike-riding environment for people of all ages and abilities. The path also is intended for people walking and running.
