# MID-COAST TROLLEY CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

## Morena Boulevard Lane and Sidewalk Closures

Starting February 19, 2019, the following traffic control and sidewalk closures will be in effect on Morena Boulevard to accommodate ongoing Mid-Coast Trolley construction activities:

- A single lane closure of northbound Morena Boulevard, from Gesner Street to Jellett Street. One lane of northbound traffic will remain open.
- A sidewalk closure at the southeast corner of the Morena Boulevard and Ingulf Street intersection.
- Intermittent closures of three driveways along Morena Boulevard, near Ingulf Street. Only one driveway with access to the businesses at the intersection will be closed at a time. See the closures map on the back of this notice for more detail. Access to businesses will be maintained at all times.

### What to Expect

- Construction activities will include demolition and reconstruction of sidewalks, roadways, and driveways.
- Work hours will be in effect Monday through Friday, 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Driveway closures will remain in place outside of work hours to allow concrete to set.
- Driveway work at the southeast corner of the intersection of Morena Boulevard and Ingulf Street will last for approximately three weeks. Roadway and sidewalk work in this area will occur in phases and is anticipated to be complete in 2020.
- Businesses may notice an increased presence of crews and work vehicles while these activities are underway. This work requires the use of heavy machinery and will generate noise. Crews will minimize impacts as much as possible.

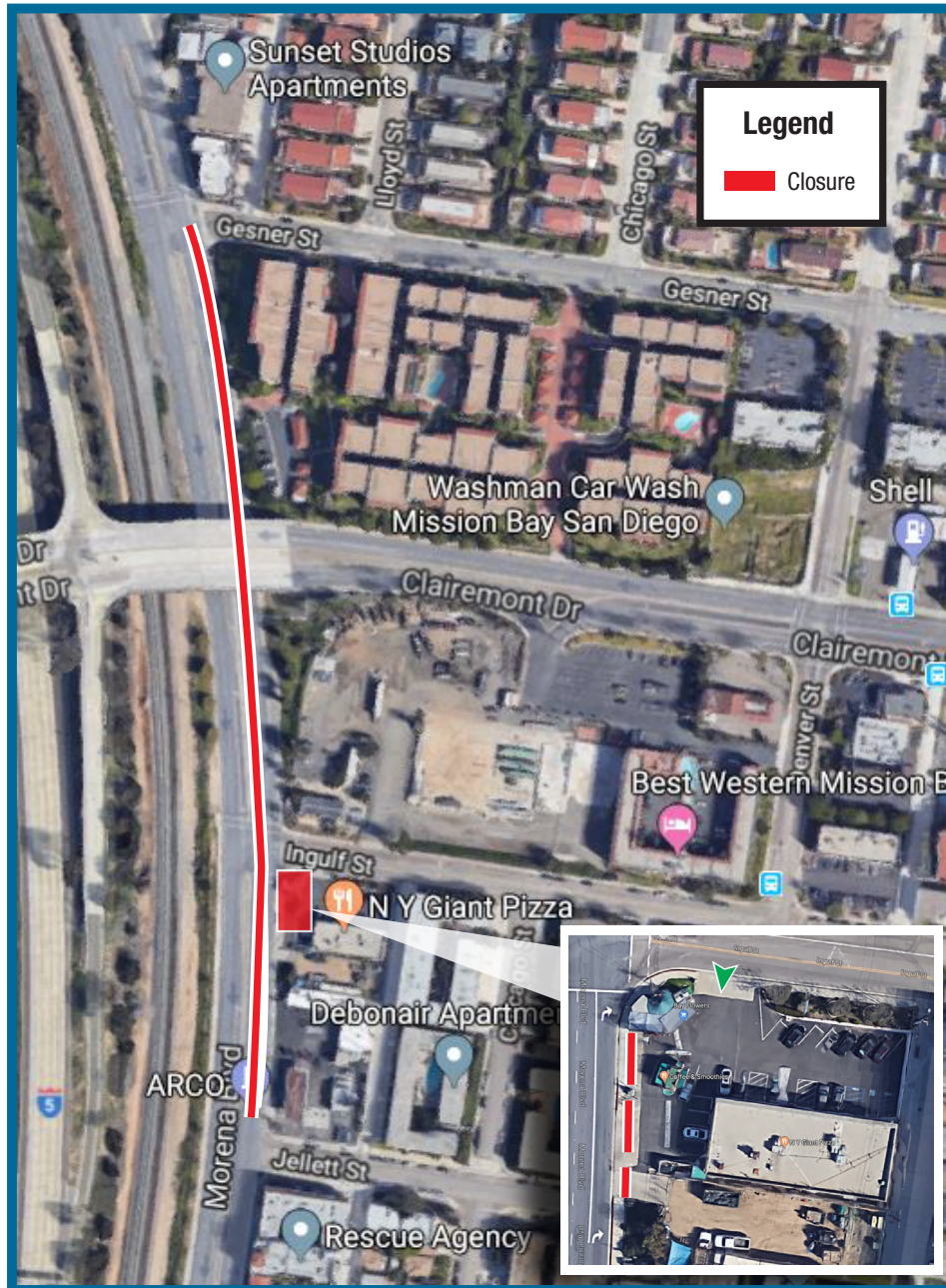

## About the Project

The Mid-Coast Trolley project will extend Trolley service from Old Town Transit Center to the University City community, serving major activity centers such as Mission Bay, the VA Medical Center, UC San Diego, and Westfield UTC. Nine new stations will be constructed. Major construction work began in 2016, with service anticipated to begin in late 2021.
