MID-COAST TROLLEY CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Morena Boulevard, Balboa Avenue, and Friars Road Construction Activities

Mid-Coast Trolley project construction will continue along Morena Boulevard, Balboa Avenue, Santa Fe Street, and Friars Road.

Main construction activities include:

- Construction of bridges, walls, stations, drainage, and related improvements within the existing rail corridor
- Street excavations and trenching
- Water and sewer pipeline installation; temporary water service interruptions will be necessary to complete this work; residents and businesses will be provided with advanced notice of service interruptions
- Temporary traffic controls along Morena Boulevard, Balboa Avenue, and Santa Fe Street
- Drilling for and construction of bridge structures over Friars Road and Balboa Avenue
- Widening of Balboa Avenue near Santa Fe Street
- Road improvement work on Morena Boulevard

Crews will minimize impacts to neighboring homes and businesses as much as possible. Access to nearby businesses will be maintained at all times.

Work Hours and Schedule

Major construction work began on the Mid-Coast Trolley project in 2016. The project is anticipated to be complete in 2021, however, work in your area may be completed prior to that date.

Due to the location and nature of the work, night and weekend work is required. Daytime work hours are Monday through Friday, from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Nighttime work hours are Sunday through Saturday, from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. There may be times when 24-hour work is required. Prior notice to residents and businesses will be provided.

About the Project

The Mid-Coast Trolley project will extend Trolley service from Old Town Transit Center to the University City community, serving major activity centers such as Mission Bay, the VA Medical Center, UC San Diego, and University Town Center. Nine new stations will be constructed, with service anticipated to begin in 2021.
