

I-5 Carpool/HOV Lanes Information and Resources



In February 2022, Caltrans and SANDAG Build NCC crews will complete nine new miles of Carpool/HOV Lanes on Interstate 5 (I-5) from Lomas Santa Fe Drive in the city of Solana Beach to Palomar Airport Road in the city of Carlsbad on northbound and southbound I-5. Construction began in 2017, and after 5 years of joint efforts, the Build NCC team will complete this major infrastructure project.

CARPOOL/HOV ACCESS INFORMATION



Dashed white lines (HOV Lane Access OK)



Double-white lines (No HOV Lane Access)

Vehicles with 2+ persons, motorcycles, vanpools, buses, or qualifying clean air vehicles, may enter and exit the Carpool/HOV Lane at the access points denoted by dashed white lines. Drivers cannot enter or exit the Carpool/HOV lane via the double-white lines. Motorists driving alone without HOV access stickers in the Carpool/HOV Lanes are subject to fines.


