For access to your home between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. during the highway closures, please show your pass to the traffic control personnel stationed at South Mission Road. If traveling west on SR 76, use the Ramona Drive detour to get to South Mission Road. The project team appreciates your patience during this construction activity. This work is part of the final segment in a series of three improvement projects on the SR 76 corridor, located between I-5 and I-15.
