

State Route 76: Project Features & Benefits



Infrastructure Improvements

- Widened and realigned SR 76 to a conventional 4-lane highway to improve traffic flow
- Installed new signalized and full access intersections
- Constructed additional on- and off-ramps to improve traffic operations and efficiency
- Replaced and constructed new bridges
- Upgraded water and utility infrastructure



Environmental, Wildlife, and Habitat Protections

- Constructed 10 animal undercrossings and 5 escape ramps
- Installed directional fencing to guide wildlife towards undercrossings
- Implemented storm water protection measures
- Created, restored, and preserved more than 1,500 acres of sensitive habitat areas with 1 million water-efficient and native plants and trees
- Supported the County of San Diego's San Luis Rey River Park plans



Safety Enhancements

- Created a concrete median barrier to separate oncoming traffic
- Realigned curves to improve sight lines and stopping distances
- Constructed new standard width shoulders in each direction to accommodate bicyclists, pedestrians, and emergency parking



Park & Ride and Old Highway 395 Upgrades

- Added 48 standard parking spaces, 3 accessible spaces, and 11 truck spaces
- Expanded mobility options by adding sidewalks and 8 electric vehicle charging stations
- Upgraded Old Highway 395 with new paving and new traffic signal at Via Altamira
