
Traffic switch to occur on November 5

Due to weather conditions, the traffic switch originally scheduled to occur last night on SR 76 in the Bonsall area has been rescheduled for Thursday night. During the switch, the traffic flow on the highway between South Mission Road and Flowerwood Lane will shift from the existing lanes on the north side of the highway to the newly constructed lanes on the south side.

In preparation for the switch, crews will temporarily close access from SR 76 to several streets: South Mission Road, Sweetgrass Lane, Ramona Drive, Calle Del Vuelta, and Via Monserate from 11 p.m. on Thursday, November 5, to 5 a.m. on Friday, November 6. Full access to SR 76 from the affected streets, except for Via Monserate, will be restored by 5 a.m., Friday, November 6. Via Monserate will remain closed for approximately two weeks, November 5 – 23, as crews work on the intersection. During this time, please use the Ramona Drive detour shown on the map.

This traffic switch will allow crews to construct and pave the north side of the highway. Caltrans will keep one westbound and one eastbound lane open between South Mission Road and Flowerwood Lane during the traffic switch. The traffic switch schedule is subject to change due to weather conditions.

Motorists are urged to slow down and use caution as they become accustomed to the roadway.
