

LANE CLOSURES ON SANTA FE STREET FOR ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS

Beginning Monday, July 11 and continuing for approximately eight weeks, crews will improve and repave the roadway on Santa Fe Street between Damon Avenue and Balboa Avenue near the businesses.

One lane will remain open to traffic during the daytime for through access to businesses. Nighttime full closures will be in place as the concrete cures. Additionally, the southbound Morena Boulevard ramp to westbound Balboa Avenue will be closed for three weeks as crews restore the roadway in coordination with the nearby improvements.

What to Expect

- Daytime lane reductions will be in place at all other times; through traffic access will be maintained
- Nighttime full closures will be in place Sunday - Thursday, from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. each night
- Full closure of the southbound Morena Boulevard ramp to westbound Balboa Avenue for three weeks for 24 hours a day
- The activities may generate noise; crews will minimize impacts as much as possible
- Please follow detour routes and signage

Construction schedules are subject to change.

About the Project

The Mid-Coast Extension of the UC San Diego Blue Line Trolley increases the regional Trolley system by 11 miles—from Downtown San Diego to the University Community—and serves major activity centers such as Mission Bay, the VA Medical Center, UC San Diego, and Westfield UTC. Major construction began in fall 2016 and included nine new Trolley stations. The Mid-Coast Trolley Extension went into service on November 21, 2021.
