Night Work Planned Along Olympic Parkway in Chula Vista

Residents can expect intermittent noise, mild vibrations, lights and lane closures overnight this week as crews install drainage improvements along Olympic Parkway between La Media Road and East Palomar Street. The work is scheduled to take place Wednesday night, October 17, and Thursday night, October 18, from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

About South Bay Rapid

The South Bay Rapid project is a \$128 million effort to provide travelers with a new, frequent, and reliable transit choice. Limited service began in September 2018. Visit sdmts.com/Rapid for Rapid Route 225 map and schedules. Following the completion of construction in early 2019, the 26-mile Rapid route will run between the Otay Mesa Port of Entry and Downtown San Diego via a dedicated transit guideway along East Palomar Street and Eastlake Parkway in Chula Vista. When completed, South Bay Rapid will connect residents to employment and activity centers in Downtown San Diego and South County.
