Please note, construction schedules are subject to change and community members may see trucks and staged equipment at various locations around the project.

Construction activities for the week of March 5

Interstate 805 to Heritage Road (Segment 1A) – City of Chula Vista

- Lane closures along westbound East Palomar Street between Davies Drive and Medical Center Drive. These closures are in place 24/7 for retaining wall and utility relocation work. Pedestrian detours will be in place. The bus stop east of Medical Center Drive has been relocated to the west side of Medical Center Drive.
- Lane and sidewalk closures along westbound East Palomar Street between Heritage Road and Paseo Ladera. These closures are in place 24/7 during sidewalk demolition and construction.
- Periodic daytime lane closures on East Palomar Street and Oleander Avenue near the intersection. These closures will allow crews to conduct preparatory work for the installation of underground communication utilities.
- Temporary bus stop closure along East Palomar Street at Brashear Place. For MTS schedules, detours, and routes during this closure, please visit www.SDMTS.com.

Heritage Road to View Park Way (Segment 1B) - City of Chula Vista

Periodic lane closures in both directions along East Palomar Street between Heritage Road and Olympic Parkway for continued road work improvements.

Olympic Parkway to State Route 125 (SR 125) (Segment 2) - City of Chula Vista

Periodic daytime closures of one westbound lane and one eastbound lane on Olympic Parkway between SB SR 125 Off-Ramp and La Media Road between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Temporary signage will be in place to alert motorists. Motorists can expect short delays.






















Olympic Parkway to State Route 125 (SR 125) (Segment 2) - City of Chula Vista (continued)

- Periodic daytime closures of the left turn pocket on northbound East Palomar Street onto Olympic Parkway between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. Temporary signage will be in place to alert motorists. Motorists can expect short delays.
- Periodic daytime traffic delays at View Park intersection as crews install new traffic signal foundations.
- Periodic noise, dust and daytime lane closures along East Palomar Street between Santa Cora Avenue and Magdalena Avenue for construction of the guideway.
- Periodic noise and dust along Impressionist Drive for construction of the guideway bridge barrier and privacy walls.

Town Center Drive to Birch Road (Segment 2) – City of Chula Vista


- Periodic noise and dust along Eastlake Parkway adjacent to Kestrel Falls Road while landscape crews continue future Otay Ranch Station platform work.
- Periodic closure of Mall Ring Road traffic while landscape crews begin irrigation and planting improvements in the area.

Millenia – City of Chula Vista

Periodic noise and dust near the Millenia development for construction of the dedicated transit guideway and Millenia Rapid Station.

Nicola Tesla Court (Segment 3) - City of San Diego

- Monday and Tuesday nights, March 5 and 6:
 - Full closure of westbound Siempre Viva Road between Paseo De Las Americas and the westbound State Route (SR 905) on-ramp between 9 p.m. – 5 a.m. as crews install the overhead sign.
 - Two lanes closed along westbound Siempre Viva Road between the westbound SR 905 onramp and eastbound SR 905 off-ramp to westbound Siempre Viva Road from 7 p.m. – 5 a.m. as crews remove an existing overhead sign.
- Wednesday, March 7:
 - Full closure of the eastbound SR 905 off-ramp to westbound Siempre Viva Road from 9 a.m. 3 p.m. as crews perform striping.

Nicola Tesla Court (Segment 3) - City of San Diego

- Thursday night, March 8:
 - Two lanes closed along eastbound Siempre Viva Road between Avenida de la Fuenta and the eastbound SR 905 on-ramp between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m. as crews begin work on the median.
 - Two lanes closed along westbound Siempre Viva Road between Paseo De Las Americas and Otay Center Drive between 7 p.m. and 5 a.m. as crews begin work on the median.
- Periodic noise and dust along the eastbound State Route (SR 905) on-ramp and off-ramp from Siempre Viva Road from construction activities on the ramps.
- Periodic noise, dust, and reduced on-street parking at Nicola Tesla Court near the Otay Mesa Port of Entry to accommodate grading and construction of underground facilities.
 - No on-street parking on south side of Nicola Tesla Court.
