



The list below shows planned construction activities for the South Bay *Rapid* project. Travelers are encouraged to allow extra time to reach their destination or consider using alternate routes. Please note, construction schedules are subject to change and community members may see trucks and staged equipment at various locations around the project.

Construction activities for the week of March 26

Interstate 805 to Heritage Road (Segment 1A) – City of Chula Vista

- Lane and sidewalk closures along westbound East Palomar Street between Heritage Road and Medical Center Drive.
 - These closures are in place 24/7 for retaining wall and utility relocation work and sidewalk work.
 - The MTS bus stop on East Palomar Street east of Medical Center Drive has been relocated to west of Medical Center Drive. Pedestrian detours will be in place.
- Periodic daytime lane closures near the intersection of East Palomar Street and Oleander Avenue. These closures will allow crews to conduct preparatory work for the installation of underground communication utilities.
- Temporary MTS bus stop closure on East Palomar Street at Brashear Place. For MTS schedules, detours, and routes during this closure, please visit www.SDMTS.com.

Heritage Road to View Park Way (Segment 1B) – City of Chula Vista

- Periodic lane closures in both directions along East Palomar Street between Heritage Road and Olympic Parkway for continued road work improvements.

Olympic Parkway to State Route 125 (SR 125) (Segment 2) – City of Chula Vista

- Periodic lane closures along northbound and southbound SR 125 between Birch Road and Olympic Parkway on Thursday, March 29, from 8 a.m.-4:30 p.m. This work will allow crews to remove temporary construction railing in advance of paving work. No detour will be necessary. Planned construction is subject to change based on weather conditions.
- Periodic daytime closures of one lane in each direction on Olympic Parkway between the southbound SR 125 off-ramp and La Media Road from 9 a.m.-5 p.m. Temporary signage will be in place to alert motorists. Motorists can expect short delays.



Olympic Parkway to State Route 125 (SR 125) (Segment 2) – City of Chula Vista (cont.)

- Full closure of the left turn lane from northbound East Palomar Street onto Olympic Parkway as crews perform new median guideway construction. Temporary signage will be in place to alert motorists. Motorists can expect short delays.
- Periodic daytime traffic delays at the View Park Way intersection as crews install new traffic signal foundations.
- Periodic noise, dust and daytime lane closures along East Palomar Street between Santa Cora Avenue and Magdalena Avenue for construction of the guideway.
- Periodic noise and dust along Impressionist Drive for construction of the guideway bridge privacy walls.

Town Center Drive to Birch Road (Segment 2) – City of Chula Vista

- **Monday – Friday nights, March 26 – March 30:** Periodic noise and light impacts along Eastlake Parkway at the intersection of Kestrel Falls and Birch roads as crews work overnight to implement traffic signal improvements.
- Periodic daytime noise and dust along Eastlake Parkway adjacent to Kestrel Falls Road while crews continue future Otay Ranch *Rapid* Station platform work.

Millenia – City of Chula Vista

- Periodic noise and dust near the Millenia development for construction of the dedicated transit guideway and Millenia *Rapid* Station.

Nicola Tesla Court (Segment 3) – City of San Diego

- One eastbound lane closed on Siempre Viva Road between Customhouse Plaza and the eastbound State Route 905 (SR 905) Siempre Viva on-ramp to allow crews to perform work on the median.
- One westbound lane closed on Siempre Viva Road between the westbound SR 905 Siempre Viva on-ramp and Otay Center Drive to allow crews to perform work on the median.
- Periodic noise and dust along the eastbound SR 905 on-ramp from Siempre Viva Road due to ramp improvements.
- Periodic noise, dust, and reduced on-street parking at Nicola Tesla Court near the Otay Mesa Port of Entry to accommodate grading and construction of underground facilities.
 - No on-street parking on south side of Nicola Tesla Court.
