



The list below shows planned construction activities for the South Bay *Rapid* project. Travelers are encouraged to allow extra time to reach their destination or consider using alternate routes. Please note, construction schedules are subject to change.

### **Construction activities for the week of August 28**

#### **Heritage Road to Olympic Parkway – City of Chula Vista**

- Periodic noise, dust, lane closures, and reduced on-street parking in both directions along East Palomar Street between Santa Flora and Heritage roads as crews install irrigation lines and plant new vegetation
- Periodic lane closures, noise, and overnight work along East Palomar Street between Santa Rosa Drive and Heritage Road on 8/29 and 8/30, for lane restriping and traffic signal upgrades
  - Motorists can expect delays along East Palomar Street between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m.
  - Nearby residents can expect intermittent noise and lights overnight between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m.

#### **Olympic Parkway to State Route 125 (SR 125) – City of Chula Vista**

- Periodic noise and dust along Impressionist Drive and lane closures along northbound and southbound SR 125 between Olympic Parkway and Birch Road for construction of the transit guideway bridge

#### **Town Center Drive to Birch Road – City of Chula Vista**

- Periodic noise and dust along Eastlake Parkway between North Driveway and Birch Road as crews install stormwater management structures
- Full closure of the Otay Ranch Town Center entry/exit point at North Driveway 24 hours a day from 10 p.m. on 8/27 until 10 p.m. on 9/1, for construction of the dedicated transit guideway
  - Nearby residents can expect intermittent noise and lights during the closure
  - Drivers can access the Otay Ranch Town Center via the Kestrel Falls Road entry/exit point
- Periodic lane closures along Eastlake Parkway at the intersections of Birch Road and Kestrel Falls Road from 8/28 to 9/1 between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m., for installation of utilities

#### **Nicola Tesla Court – City of San Diego**

- Periodic noise, dust, and reduced on-street parking at Nicola Tesla Court near the Otay Mesa Port of Entry to construct a new pedestrian path and excavate for a new retaining wall
  - Overnight work at Nicola Tesla Court from 7 p.m. on 8/26 until 5 a.m. on 8/27 as crews pour asphalt for the new pedestrian path
