Night Work Planned at La Media Road in Chula Vista

Night work is planned for **Tuesday, February 12, at 9 p.m. through Wednesday, February 13, at 4 a.m.** at the intersection of East Palomar Street and La Media Road to accommodate improvements to enhance the nearby traffic signals. During this time, the left turn lane from eastbound East Palomar Street to northbound La Media Road will be closed to allow crews to work on the installation of traffic signal loops. Residents can expect intermittent noise, including OSHA required back up alarms, lights, and reduced traffic lanes overnight as crews complete this work.

All reasonable steps will be taken to minimize impacts to nearby residents, businesses and travelers. We appreciate your patience during construction. Please note, construction schedules are subject to change.

About South Bay Rapid

The South Bay *Rapid* project is a \$139 million effort to provide travelers with a new, frequent, and reliable transit choice. The 26-mile *Rapid* route runs between the Otay Mesa Port of Entry and Downtown San Diego via a dedicated transit guideway along East Palomar Street and Eastlake Parkway in Chula Vista. Now operational, South Bay *Rapid* connects residents to employment and activity centers in Downtown San Diego and South County.
